#### **9.19.25 DIT MEETING**

The District Implementation Team (DIT) is focusing on several key initiatives, including planning for the upcoming school climate surveys for staff, students, and families, with a target completion date of January 30, 2026. The team is also working to strengthen the SWPBIS Tier 3 system following recent TFI assessments, which will involve an administrative meeting to identify potential barriers and action items. Additionally, the DIT is reviewing last year's District Capacity Assessment (DCA) results to focus on areas scoring low and will retake the assessment in April to create a new action plan. Finally, they are developing an electronic version of the MTSS/PBIS binder for the 2026-27 school year, which will ensure teachers' physical binders remain up-to-date.

### NEXT STEPS

We are actively enhancing Professional Learning by securing training in Restorative Practices and Kagan Structures. To ensure our efforts meet everyone's needs, we are also developing a district-wide professional development survey to gather and analyze data. Additionally, we are simplifying our MTSS Drive access by creating a new organizational system that will make all necessary documents easier for staff to locate and use.
